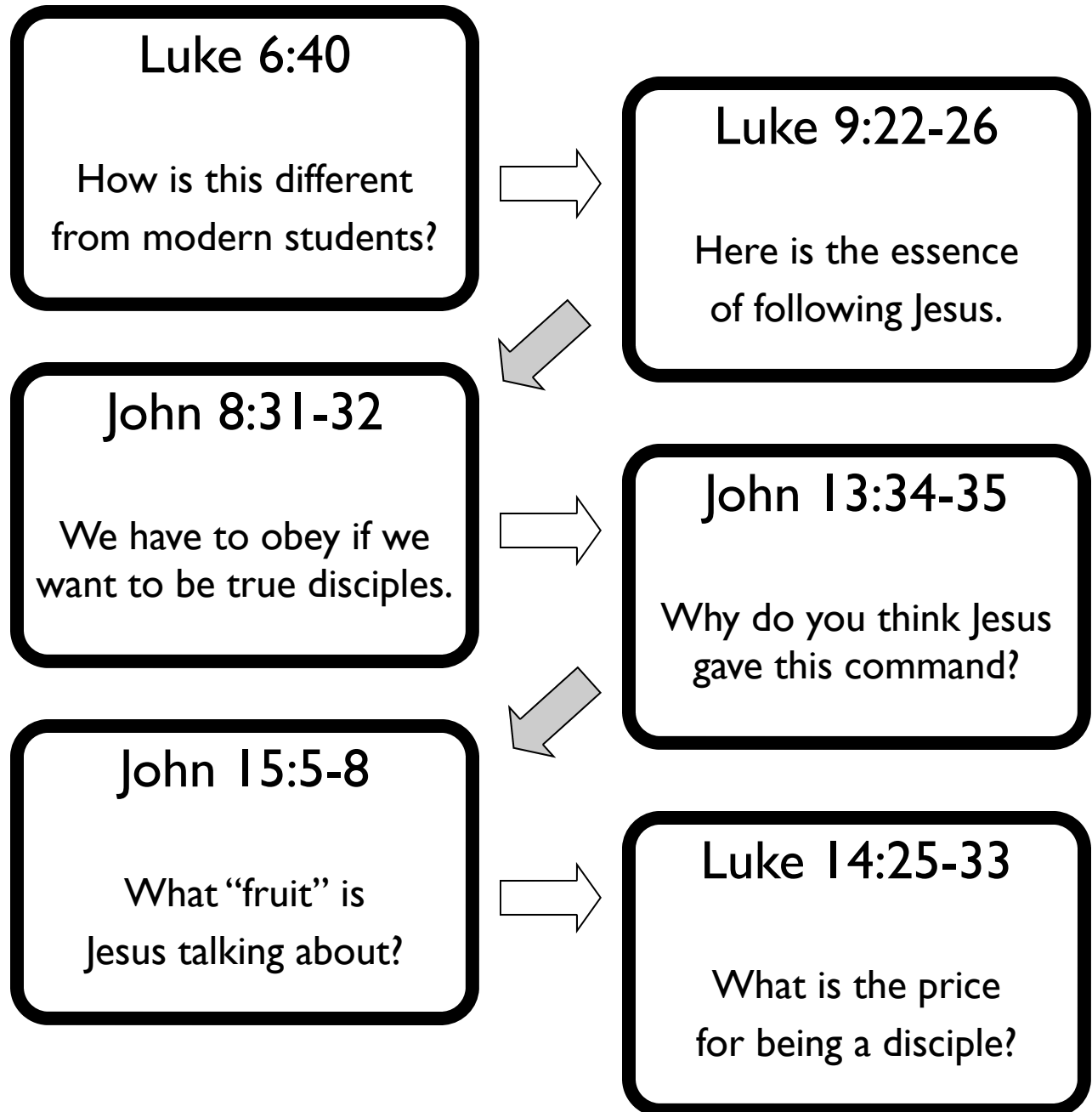


DISCIPLESHIP
